

THE BRITISH COLUMBIA HEALTH CARE SCHOLARSHIP FUND

In addition to assistance from the FBA Education Fund, members covered under the 2006-2010 *Health Services & Support Facilities Subsector* collective agreement may receive additional funding through B.C.'s Ministry of Advanced Education – **Health Care Bursary** or **Nurses Education Bursary**.

The British Columbia Health Care Bursary – which awards up to \$1 million in scholarship funding each year – was established to train workers in skills shortage areas within the health care system.

Bursaries range from \$500 to \$3,500 and successful applicants are only eligible to receive **one** per year.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS?

You must meet ALL of the following:

- you have been a permanent B.C. resident for the last 12 months;
- you do not have a current outstanding student loan;
- during the bursary period for which you are applying, you are enrolled in an ELIGIBLE health care program of study at least four months' long at a B.C. **public** post-secondary institution, St. Paul's Hospital or the B.C. Cancer Agency, that leads to a certificate, diploma or degree **recognized for practice in B.C.** (see <u>Appendix A</u> for a complete list of eligible programs and institutions), and
- you can demonstrate financial need.

WHAT IS THE APPLICATION PROCEDURE?

You can download <u>application forms</u>, <u>reference codes</u>, and <u>tips</u> on how to complete the application form from the <u>Ministry of Advanced Education</u> – Student Services Branch, or your union's <u>website</u>.

WHEN ARE THE BURSARY DEADLINES?

- January to April courses deadline November 15, 4:30 PM
- May to August courses deadline March 15, 4:30 PM
- September to December deadline July 15, 4:30 PM
