Re: Application for Provincial Executive Sub-Committees

Attached you will find an invitation for HEU members to apply to participate in one of the five Provincial Executive Sub-Committees: Environment, Global Justice and Peace, Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S), Young Workers, and Men.

As you will recall, delegates to the 2014 HEU Convention combined the Support, Patient Care, Trades and Maintenance, Patient Care Technical, and Clerical Occupational Sub-Committees into one Occupational Sub-Committee. This new committee has already started their work and includes representation from each of the five occupational groups and from the public, contracted support, and independent sectors.

- supporting continued discussion with men to end violence against women
- physical and mental health issues affecting men in a changing society
- resources that provide support to men
- building links with groups that can assist the committee in their work
