HEU members are the driving force of our strong and diverse union. To support greater member involvement, HEU has a Member Facilitators Program, which offers members the opportunity to gain skills and experience in facilitating education sessions for fellow members.

HEU is recruiting members to train them to facilitate various workshops, including our 1-Day Getting Involved, some Shop Steward workshops and our Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) Basic Rights workshops. Preparing members for these roles will start with a three-day Member Facilitators Training that will be offered on **September 6-8, 2023, at Provincial Office, Burnaby.**

During the training, members will gain knowledge and skills in popular education and facilitating techniques and practice delivering these facilitation skills. Members participating will be assessed for readiness, and those members will have an opportunity to facilitate or assist in facilitating workshops in their region.


When scheduled to facilitate a workshop, members will be booked off work and entitled to claim lost wages and expenses. There will be no additional compensation to members participating in the Member Facilitators Program. Members applying should be prepared to commit to this program for the next 18 to 24 months.
