Using a curriculum developed by the CLC Women's and Human Rights Department and Western University, in partnership with a community-based violence prevention organization, this two-day workshop explores the ways that union members can support those experiencing domestic violence.

The workshop is an opportunity for those attending to:


- Gain a deeper understanding of the dynamics of domestic violence at work and the role of the union and employer in addressing it.

- Learn about referral pathways to community-based experts
