RE: CANADIAN LABOUR CONGRESS PACIFIC REGION WINTER SCHOOL JANUARY 11 – FEBRUARY 4, 2021 (VIRTUAL)

The 2021 CLC Pacific Region Winter School will take place virtually over four weeks from January 11 to February 4, 2021. Each week will run Monday to Thursday.

The course schedule and course descriptions are attached for your reference. HEU will cover the cost of registration and wage loss for a selected number of participants.

Members selected will attend **one** week-long course only. The general model will include a two-hour live session in the morning and a two-hour live session in the afternoon, with the rest of the time left for breaks and for students to work on their own or perhaps in small groups. Individual course times will be set by the facilitators of each course. In addition, each night, there will be a free, public panel to hear from guest speakers about topics important to the labour movement.

Please note, courses will be conducted virtually via Zoom. Students are required to have a working computer or tablet with audio-visual capabilities and an internet connection.
