Re: Break Open, Bust Out: Authentic Leadership for Women of Colour – July 3 & 4, 2019

The Break Open, Bust Out training is an opportunity for HEU members who are women of colour (mixed/biracial, Indigenous, and trans-identified women of colour) and who want to further develop their leadership skills.

Inside and outside of our union, women of colour can experience barriers to participation and leadership. This training is designed to aid, support and encourage women of colour to bring more of who they are and what they offer to union work. This course creates space for reflection, personal growth and building strong leadership skills.

HEU recognizes and honours the complexity of intersectional identities and is committed to supporting women of colour to excel in leadership roles within the union.

Course topics include:

- Reclaiming vulnerability, valuing emotions as information
- Implicit bias messages we absorb
- Accessing personal power, reclaiming our story
- Authentic communications, recognizing and unhooking from triggers
- Playing to our strengths, growing our inner warrior
- What would we be doing if we had more positional/collective power or felt more powerful?
