This year's theme – "The RESISTERhood – Working Woman Organizing for Collective Power" – focuses on organizing and collective action as central to the advancement of working women's issues and building power for all workers. It also reflects our commitment to creating an environment that is inclusive and builds on the strength of our shared but also uniquely different experiences as women from diverse backgrounds in the broader labour movement. The institute uses the spelling of the word 'woman' to be inclusive of gender non-conforming and transgender women.

This year's SIUW will provide an "organizer's boot camp" to emerging new leaders. Participants will be able to choose from classes that offer hands-on training including:

- mobilizing members in difficult times
- building inclusive organizations
- organizing against sexual harassment
- bargaining for racial justice and immigrant rights
- unions, worker centres and community allies campaigning for a common goal, and so much more.

HEU will send a limited number of women to the SIUW. For successful applicants, HEU will cover the cost of registration, transportation, wages, and accommodations. Full per diems will be provided for travel days, however, meals are provided each day with registration fees. Therefore, your per diems will be adjusted accordingly (Canadian funds). Accommodations will be provided as arranged by the Institute organizers. Details can be found in the application form.

The conference starts with an opening reception and plenary at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 10 and ends at 2:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 14, with registration from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 10.
