Ombudsperson's recommendations in her December 2009 report, "The Best of Care: Getting It Right for Seniors in British Columbia (Part 1)," including a comprehensive, user-friendly website that would publicly report current, detailed information about residential care facilities and an expanded role for resident and family councils backed by legislation and regulations.

This week, HEU met once more with the Ombudsperson to discuss the impact of provincial government underfunding of seniors' care that's resulted in significant fee increases for those living in long-term care, the contracting out of care and support staff in residential facilities, and cuts to services and programs for seniors in communities around B.C.
