Protest at the Hyatt – support Vancouver hotel workers on July 22

Hotel employees in Vancouver – along with supporters – will join 50,000 fellow workers in 15 cities across North America on July 22 to protest against low wages and poor working conditions.

About 1,600 union members – UniteHere! Local 40 – working at the Hyatt, Four Seasons, Westin Bayshore and Renaissance hotels are bargaining a new contract. All of these hotels are operated by wealthy multinational corporations.

At issue are job cuts, increased workload, and occupational health and safety concerns.

The majority of hotel workers are women and immigrants, who deserve safe jobs and family-supporting wages.
