BC Supreme Court issues decision on political protest

The BC Supreme Court today issued a decision related to the charter implications of union protests held on January 28, 2003.

The court confirmed the conclusions of a December 2004 Labour Relations Board reconsideration panel decision that found that the union's protests on that day did not fall within the freedom of expression provisions contained in the *Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms*.

The union and its legal counsel are reviewing today's judgement.
