The province of British Columbia has proclaimed October 18 as “Health Care Assistant Day”

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

On Tuesday, October 18, HEU locals have a special opportunity to honour the extraordinary contribution care aides and community health workers bring to the health care team.

Health Care Assistant Day was proclaimed in July by Lieutenant Governor Steven L. Point and is the result of a collaborative effort by stakeholders – including unions, educators, employers and government representatives – on the Care Aide & Community Health Worker Registry advisory committee.

At a provincial level, the union will be marking the day with a variety of public awareness activities aimed at increasing the profile of these front-line caregivers who provide such critical personal care to British Columbians in our communities.

At the local level, we encourage you to host activities at your worksites that recognize care aides and community health workers.

For example, you may want to offer cake and cookies or create and display a banner of thanks. You can distribute “Proud to be a Care Aide” buttons to your care aide members. And don’t forget to post the enclosed proclamation on your union bulletin board along with a poster that will be available to download and print from the union website.



In whatever ways you decide to mark the day, your efforts will go a long way toward making October 18 a day of recognition and appreciation for health care assistants at your worksite.

A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS there are over 37,000 Health Care Assistants providing front-line care and service that assists British Columbians to remain independent as long as possible, and

WHEREAS Health Care Assistants provide 24 hour professional care and supervision in protective and supportive environments for people who have complex care needs, and

WHEREAS Health Care Assistants work in a variety of settings including acute care, residential care, home and community care including independent living and assisted living, and

WHEREAS Health Care Assistants have demonstrated to be an indispensable component in the safety and quality of personal care for patients, clients and residents, and

WHEREAS the demand for Health Care Assistants is ever increasing with the aging of the population and the continual growth of health care services, and

WHEREAS the Government of British Columbia wishes to join with the residents across the Province in recognizing Health Care Assistants, and

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002,

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that October 18, 2011, shall be known as

“Health Care Assistant Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.
